## **Typical Answer of the American Studies Exam**

I. Give a short definition for the following term: 1 point

**Soft power:** A foreign policy concept used to describe any country's use of nonmilitary power to convince other countries to ascribe to its policies.

- II. Explain the following quotations: 6 points for each quotation in a paragraph form.
- 1. "Obama has no particular principles that I can identify. In fact, the advertising industry enthusiastically gave the best marketing campaign of the year to Obama, the year he was first elected. [...] So, we really have no reason to be surprised." (Noam Chomsky, November 15, 2014)
- The quotation is a criticism of Obama's presidency. He has been president for six years and yet he did not do anything to develop America domestically and internationally. (1 point)
- Chomsky harshly criticizes Obama as he is just another Establishment candidate who wants to become president (1 point)
- Obama's uniqueness, according to Chomsky, lies in the fact he used an effective campaign based on social media and marketing to promote the idea he was the first African-American elected president who might bring about a change (1 point)
- African-Americans disappointed from Obama / Failed to find ways to make changes for minority groups
  / # BLM rising (1 point)
- Using drones (542 strikes leading to 3797 people killed) (1 point)
- Obama's realpolitik and being a realistic president (focusing on constitution rather than ethical considerations) (1 point)
- 2. "Let America be America again. Let it be the dream it used to be. Let it be the pioneer on the plain. Seeking a home where he himself is free. Let America be the dream the dreamers dreamed. Let it be that great strong land of love." (African-American poet Langston Hughes, 1935)
- The poem speaks of the American Dream (1.5 point)
- Disillusionment from being unable to achieve the dream (1.5 point)
- Reclaiming the American Dream for all Americans (African-Americans, Native Americans, White working class, European and Jewish immigrants) (1.5 point)
- Thoughts about what it was truly like to live in America of 1935 of the Great Depression (1.5 point)

## III. Answer the following question: 6 points in a paragraph form How did the United States foreign policy change after 9/11?

- Bush launched War on Terror in Afghanistan and Iraq, preemptive war, axis of evil (2 points)
- Victims, casualties, Arab hatred, US soft power went down (2 points)
- Setting up of the Guantanamo Bay detention camp in 2002 (Habeas corpus, negative image of America, torture) (2 points)
